I. Evil, wickedness and sin are real.

“Woe to those who call evil good and good evil.” **Isaiah 5:20**

“Out of the heart come evil thoughts, murder, adultery, sexual immorality, theft, false witness, slander.” **Matthew 15:19**

“The sluggard says, “There’s a lion outside! I’ll be killed in the public square!”
Proverbs 22:13

“Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but we trust in the name of the LORD our God.” **Psalms 20:7**

“When the foundations are being destroyed, what can the righteous do?” **Psalms 11:1-3**

II. God’s sovereignty combating our fear.
