"And Jacob was left alone." Genesis 32:24

III. When God comes against us, that is not always a bad thing.

"A man wrestled with him until the breaking of the day... So Jacob called the name of the place Peniel, saying, "For I have seen God face to face, and yet my life has been delivered." Genesis 32:24 & 30

IV. A new name (and -no-it is not "Gimpy")

Then he said, "Your name shall no longer be called Jacob, but Israel, for you have striven with God and with men, and have prevailed." Genesis 32:28

ישראל - Ya-Shar-EL

Hebrew "Shar" – (not just "wrestle" or "strive") – Hebrew root to rule or reign as a Prince. Same as Isaiah 9:6 "and the *government* shall be upon his shoulder."

Israel or "Prevailing Prince of God"
