II. All things are from Him and through Him and to Him in Creation and Providence.

A. In Creation:

1. All things are from Him

Genesis 1:1 “In the beginning God created...”

John 1:1-3 “In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through him, and without him was not any thing made that was made.

2. All things are through Him

Hebrews 1:3 “He (Jesus) is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power.”
